Vaccination Certificate Requirements

For entry into Singapore, a valid yellow fever vaccination certificate is required from travellers who, within the preceding six days, have been in or have passed through any country endemic for yellow fever. The International Certificate of Vaccination for yellow fever is considered valid 10 days after vaccination and is valid for a period of 10 years.

Successful applicants without vaccination certificates or with vaccination certificates that are less than 10 days old will be subjected to a risk assessment by the Airport Health Office. If entry is denied, he or she will be required to take the next flight out of Singapore.
